Adelaide Biodiversity Bibliography

A bibliography of publications and research regarding biodiversity issues and conservation in the Adelaide Metropolitan Area

This bibliography covers published and unpublished resources relating to biodiversity issues and conservation in the Adelaide Metropolitan Area. It does not claim to be exhaustive. The resources included have been selected on the basis of how useful the content will be to people working on biodiversity projects in the Adelaide Metropolitan Area. Resources containing relatively little original information or that are largely based on information from other sources have not been included.

The geographical area covered by the SA Urban Forest Biodiversity Program (SAUFBP) Bibliography extends from the Gawler River in the north to the Willunga Scarp in the south and is bounded by the Adelaide coastline on the west and the Hills Face Zone on the east (see map). Some publications relate to the Adelaide Hills as well as the Hills Face Zone.

Pre-European Vegetation of Adelaide: A survey from the Gawler River to Hallett Cove by D.N. Kraehenbuehl (1996) contains a wealth of material on the original vegetation of the Adelaide Plains area and the bibliography of this publication contains reference to many primary records drawn from articles and reports in newspapers and journals such as *South Australian Naturalist* and *South Australian Ornithologist*, some of which have been included in this bibliography. Both the text and references of this book should be consulted for information relating to the vegetation of specific sites in the Adelaide area.

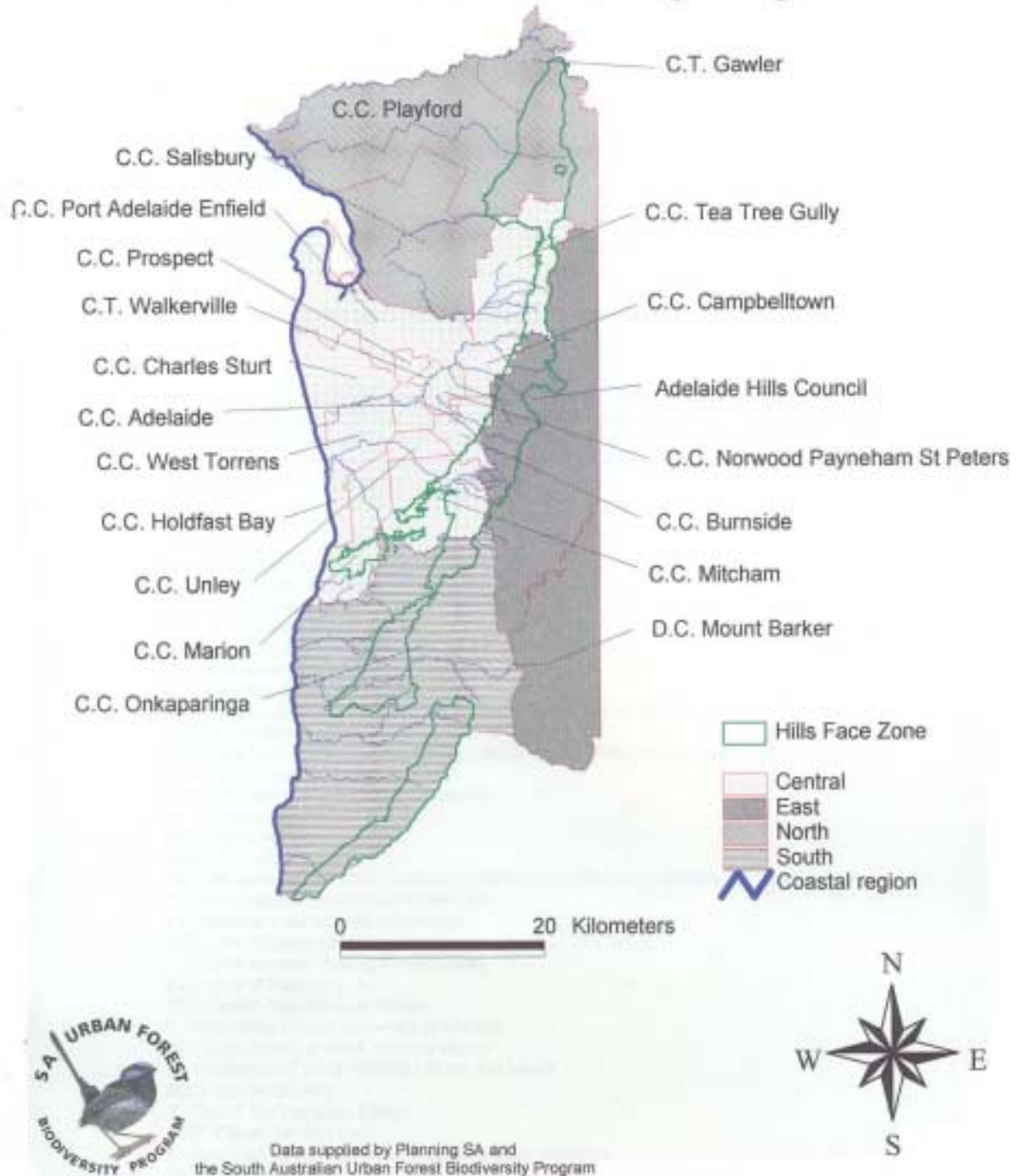
Using this bibliography

Adelaide Biodiversity Bibliography is divided into two sections. Part 1 covers resources that relate to specific sites or areas, for example, Hallett Cove, Watiparinga Reserve, Angove Conservation Park. Part 2 contains resources that are general reference materials on specific topics, for example, native orchids, reptiles, birds of Adelaide or South Australia; soil and vegetation survey methods, and lists of threatened species.

The listings are divided into a number of headings - title; author/published by (person or agency); year of publication; type of publication; region it applies to; source (library or other place where it is available); summary of relevant content; key words.

Resources can be located by using the title of the publication but in many instances, the title may not be enough to easily locate a resource on a specific topic or area. An alternative is to scan the extreme right hand column, Key Words, in which the main topic or area is the first entry. If the bibliography is being used in an electronic form, the tables can be sorted in such a way to aid the location of specific resources.
